- In preparation for the Puyallup swapfest, volunteers will meet at President Nelson Spohnheimer's QTH on Sat Mar 3 to load equipment into Treasurer Duane Gibb's van for transportation to Puyallup on late Friday afternoon Mar 9. - George Hoffman W7POE made the contest calendar report emphasizing the ARRL DX contest. He also presented some analysis of his participation in the ARRL DX CW contest. George also gave the propagation report showing still decreasing solar activity.
